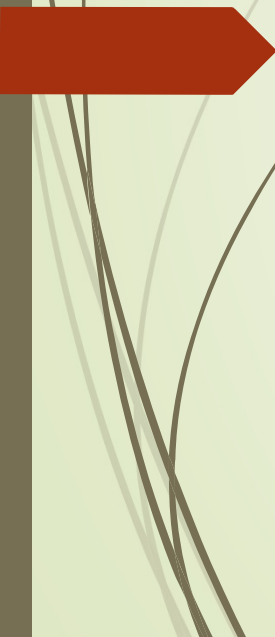

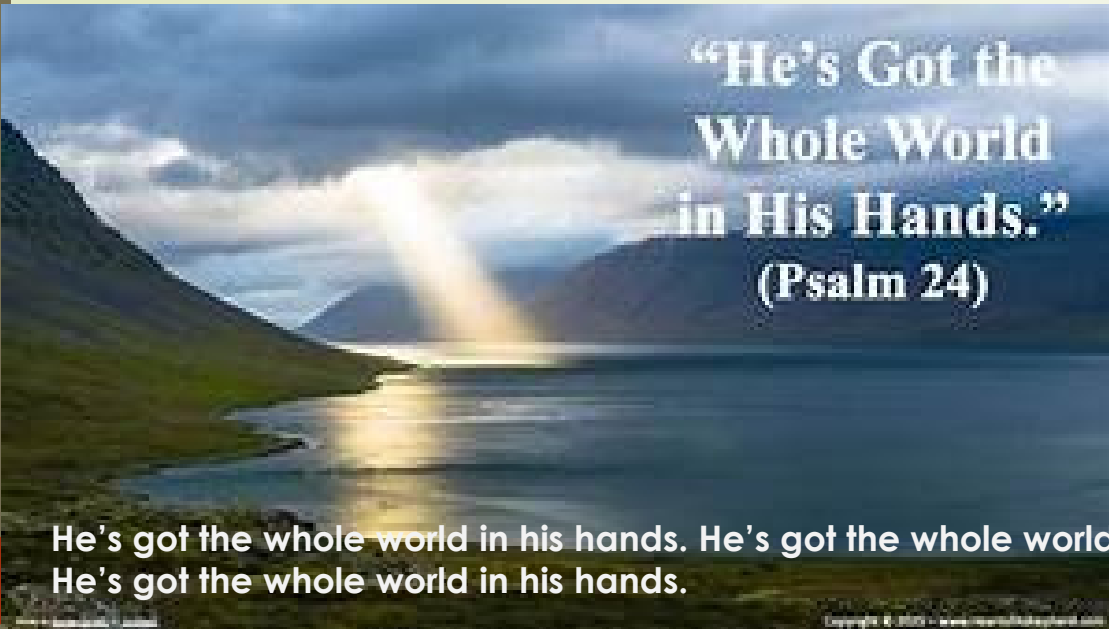
Assurance of Pardon
