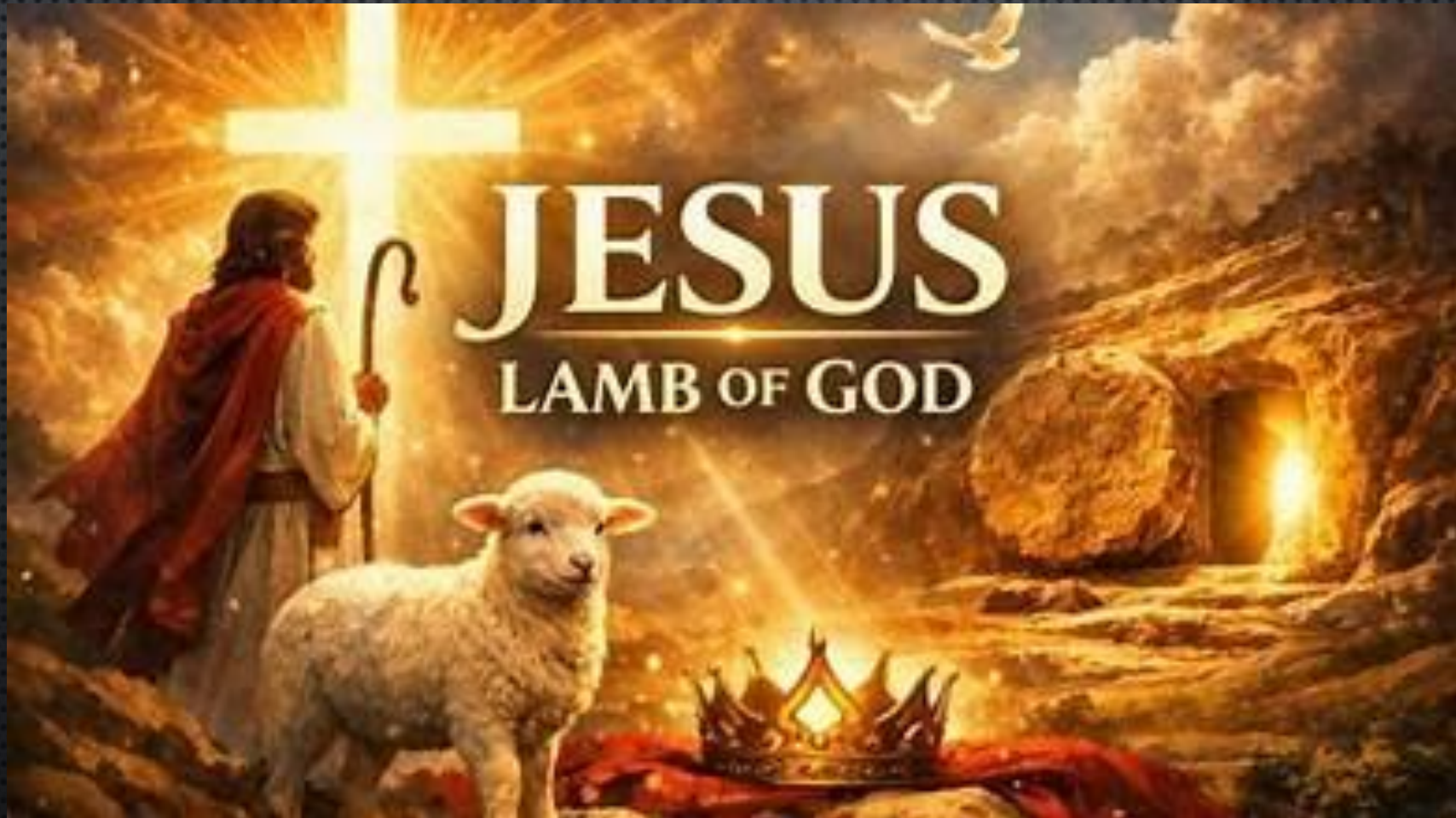

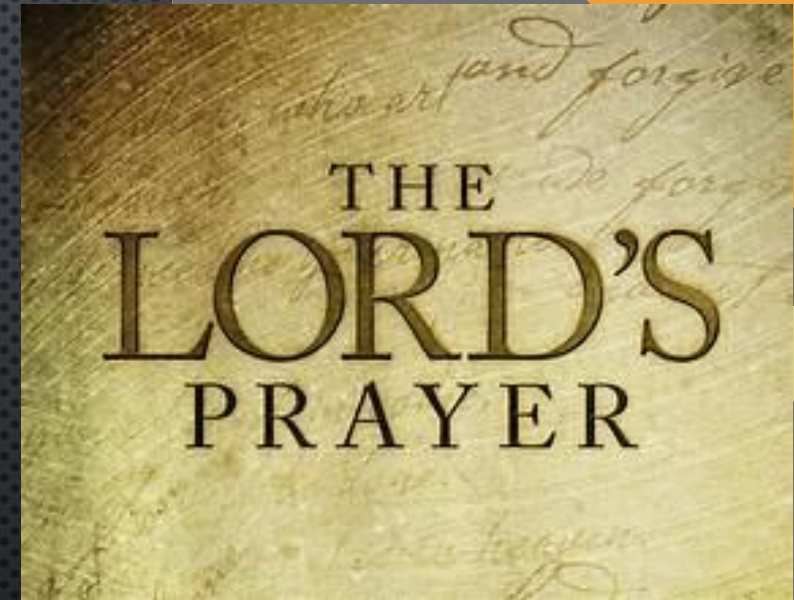

And from beneath, above and all ways:

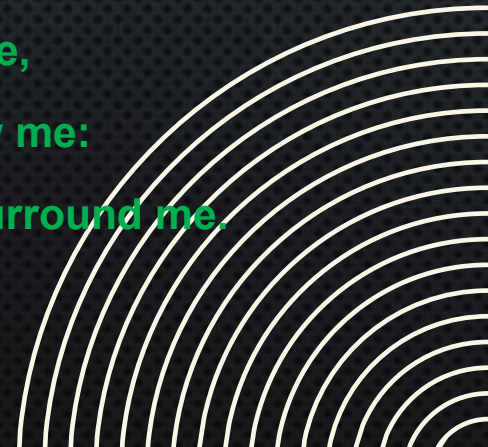
